(SE11/0189) Program 2.1: Refugee and Humanitarian Assistance

Senator Hanson-Young (L&CA 22) asked:

Since February 2011, how many people have been resettled from Malaysia?

Answer:

Between 1 February 2011 and 17 October 2011, 722 people were granted humanitarian visas by the Australian High Commission, Kuala Lumpur.¹ Of these:

- 689 were subclass 200 (Refugee) visas
- 20 were subclass 202 (Special Humanitarian Program) visas
- 13 were subclass 204 (Woman at Risk) visas

1. Data for the period 1 February 2011 to 30 June 2011 was extracted from departmental systems on 30 June 2011. Data for 1 July 2011 onwards was extracted from departmental systems on 4 November 2011.
