### SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES HEARING: 17 OCTOBER 2011

#### IMMIGRATION AND CITIZENSHIP PORTFOLIO

#### (SE11/0290) Program 4.3: Offshore Asylum Seeker Management

Senator Michaela Cash (L&CA 20) asked:

In relation to the Malaysian Solution, provide exactly the amount of money allocated in the budget for expenditure

*Answer:*

The agreement with Malaysia announced in the 2011-12 Budget is comprised of two separate expense measures, namely 'Regional Cooperation Framework - Transfer of Irregular Maritime Arrivals to Malaysia' and 'Humanitarian Migration Program – increase of 4,000 places'.

The money allocated in the 2011-12 Budget to each measure (excluding depreciation expenses not requiring appropriation) is as follows:

#### a) Regional Cooperation Framework – Transfer of Irregular Maritime Arrivals to Malaysia
