**SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES HEARING: 17 OCTOBER 2011**

**IMMIGRATION AND CITIZENSHIP PORTFOLIO**

**(SE11/0384) Program 4.2: Onshore Detention Network**

Senator Cash asked:

How many IMA crew members are in immigration detention and in which locations?

*Answer:*

As at COB 17 October 2011, there were 57 Indonesian crew in immigration detention on Christmas Island and the Australian mainland. Of these:

- five adults and three minors were accommodated on Christmas Island;
- 35 adults and nine minors were accommodated in Darwin;
- three adults and two minors were accommodated in Melbourne.
