- 1. What was the total amount spent by the Commonwealth in this litigation?
- 2. How many lawyers from the Australian Government Solicitor were involved in this litigation?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

AGS has been instructed not to disclose the resources associated with the Commonwealth's defence of the legal actions regarding plain packaging on the grounds that public disclosure of this information may confer a tactical advantage on other parties in the ongoing litigation.
