In relation to the 195 applicants for injunctions to prevent removal, if 79 applicants have discontinued their applications for injunctions, what happens if they are 'not available for removal'?

Answer:

The Department can only remove clients in accordance with section 198 of the *Migration Act 1958*. What happens to each of these individual applicants will depend on their own particular facts and circumstances.
