SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES HEARING: 19 November 2013

IMMIGRATION AND BORDER PROTECTION PORTFOLIO

(SE13/0240) PROGRAM – 4.2: Onshore Detention Network

Senator Carr (Written) asked:

How many people who have arrived by boat since 7 September are currently in immigration detention on the Australian mainland? Of those, how many are women, children and unaccompanied minors?

Answer:

As at 15 November 2013, there have been 1222 arrivals post 7 September 2013. Of these there are 65 women, 84 accompanied minors and 23 unaccompanied minors currently in immigration detention in Australia.
