

QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE

SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES HEARING: 19 November 2013

(SE13/0025) PROGRAMME – 2.1: Refugee and Humanitarian Assistance

Senator Carr (L&CA 57) asked:

Senator CARR: I am interested in how many places have already been filled of that 11,000 and you are giving me figures going back to September. Ms Larkins: I can take that on notice. I do not have that with me. Senator Carr: How many of those were from Indonesia? Ms Larkins: I do not have that with me. I would have to take that on notice. Senator CARR: Malaysia? Ms Larkin: Again, I do not have that detail with me. Senator CARR: Can you take that on notice, please. Ms Larkins: I will.

Answer:

As at 19 November 2013, 3491 Offshore Humanitarian visas have been granted in the 2013–14 programme year.
