SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES HEARING: 19 November 2013

IMMIGRATION AND BORDER PROTECTION PORTFOLIO

(SE13/0188) PROGRAMME – Internal Product

Senator Ludwig (Written) asked:

a) How many ongoing staff left the department/agency from 7 September 2013 to date? What classification were these staff? b) How many non-ongoing staff left department/agency from 7 September 2013 to date? What classification were these staff?

Answer:

There were 175 separations from the department between 7 September 2013 and 19 November 2013 (76 ongoing and 99 non-ongoing) as indicated in the table below. This excludes any Machinery of Government changes.
