Who conducted the work, how many staff were involved and how long did it take to make all the changes?

Answer:

Staff from across the department were involved in updating systems and information products to reflect the department's name change, most of which was conducted as business as usual.

This included staff in Technology Services Division, National Communications Branch, People Strategy and Services Division, Programme Transition Branch, Detention Infrastructure Branch, Visa and Offshore Services Division, Performance Analysis and Network Initiatives Section, Global Network Planning Branch, Client Correspondence Team, Ministerial Executive and External Accountability Branch, Migration and Citizenship Policy Division, overseas posts, Forms Services, and Legal and Assurance Division.
