ADDITIONAL ESTIMATES 2007

I write regarding my statements provided at the Additional Estimates Hearing of 15 February 2007.

At the time of the Hearing I provided information which I would like to amend in order to provide further clarification to the responses. The excerpts appear in Hansard as follows:

Page: RRA&T 112

Line: line 8

Mr Yates—'We had a further meeting via telephone hook-up in Darwin on 30 January in which we reviewed the plan that I had discussed at the last <u>meeting</u>.

Could 'meeting' be replaced with 'Estimates Hearing'.

Page: RRA&T 112

Line: 20

Mr Yates – Not all the rehabilitation has been a complete success, <u>because of the</u> learning,

Could 'because of the' be replaced with 'but this enables' learning,

Page: RRA&T 112

Line: 36

Mr Yates –These are the areas that were mined by the predecessors to <u>the current</u> pinnacle fields.

Could 'the current' be replaced with 'PRL to become' pinnacle fields.

Page: RRA&T 112

Line: 37

Mr Yates -There are other areas where we should be able to overtime.

This should read: 'There are other areas where we should be able to **rehabilitate** over time.'

I would like to request that the above amendments be placed on the record relating to the 2007 Additional Estimates session.
