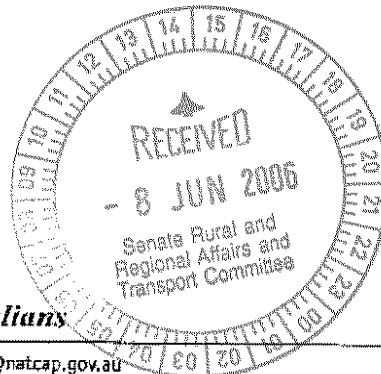
Dear Ms Le Guen
