In the course of preparing a response to a question on notice arising from the Additional Senate Estimates Hearing, conducted on February 2010, the department has determined that a response provided to a question on notice CPD 21 in October 2009, regarding costs associated with a Biofuels review, was inaccurate.

The department has now determined that ABARE costs associated with the review were not fully included with the response in October 2009. Question on notice CPD21 was framed in terms of the reviews (or similar) done in the Department in the period 2008-09.

The original response on biofuels included the costs incurred during the 2008-09 financial year. However, the review was commenced in 2007-08 and incurred additional costs in that year, which were not reported.

This has been updated in the context of the 6 February 2010 Additional Estimates hearings. Attachment A, reporting the cost of the entire review, provides our correction of CPD21 from the Supplementary Budget Estimates hearings in October 2009 for the consideration of the committee.
