

Objections to the Lockhart Committee Recommendations:

1. Recommendation 24: I object to this recommendation because it is extremely dangerous to mix animal and human tissue in this way because of the danger of inter species viral infections. Even though it is recommended that implantation should not be allowed, plenty of errors have occurred with implantation in IVF procedures, eg wrong embryo being implanted. It is too easy for errors to occur for interspecies tissue to be used in this way.
2. Recommendation 17: I object to this recommendation for similar reasons. It is foolhardy and extremely dangerous to permit interspecies fertilisation because of the risk of inter species virus transmission.


