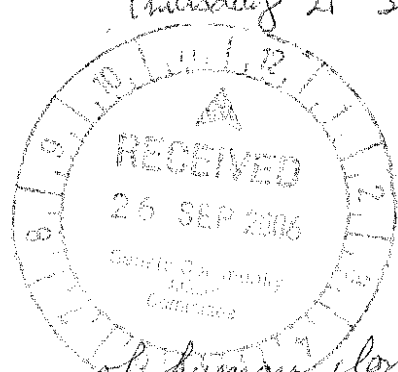

Dear Sir/Madam

Re: Australian-wide ban on all forms of human cloning.

I believe that there are two new pro-cloning bills to be presented shortly to Parliament which support the Lockhart Committee's recommendations. Recommendation 24 reads "In order to reduce the need for human oocytes, transfer of human somatic cell nuclei into animal oocytes should be allowed," — this means intertwining & combining harvested eggs & genetic material from both animal & human derivation. I believe this is terribly wrong & I ask your committee recommend to Parliament that they uphold the current Australian ban (which was supported by all Australian M.P.s in 2002) on all forms of human cloning.
