Dear Secretary,

It has come to my notice that Senator Scott Despoja has introduced legislation into the Senate - The Transparent Advertising and Notification of Pregnancy Counselling Services Bill 2005, to place restrictions and borders on Pro-life Counselling under the guise that such service by PCC's advertise that - this service does not provide referrals for termination of pregnancy.

The absurd claim that such advertisements are, in effect, false providers for failing to include abortion recommendations in their counselling.

The real false providers are those advertising abortion since they do NOT detail all difficulties associated with abortion - physical, social & psychological etc which can last a life time.

Such a law envisaged is without a doubt ~~the WORST~~ KIND of legislation that could ever be proposed. Let it be quite understood that the consequences of the committee disregarding or downplaying objections could entail a litany of law suits charging that law is tilted towards pro-abortion lobby.
