Palm oil is found about 40 percent of the food products on our shelves and its rampant cultivation is destroying the Orangutan's habitat at an alarming rate. - The United Nations has warned that Orangutans could be extinct within a generation if we don't act quickly.

Once palm oil is labeled, consumers can actually drive a market for proper certified sustainable palm oil because they can demand it of manufacturers

These are a few rational reasons why palm oil should be labeled in products. Some of the major food manufacturers have switched to sustainable palm oil practices but it isn't wide spread enough.

What I would also put to the committee is to ask yourselves what you want to be remembered for?
