Re: Commonwealth Seniors Card

I wish to submit the following facts for considration re the income limits set to enable non-pensioners to qualify for the above card.

- 1. Income limits have not been increased for several years or possibly since the card was introduced (not even CPI adjustments)
- 2. An added anomaly now exists in that most superannuation pensions and in particular most State Government pensions, are now taxfree and the pension does not count towards the \$80,000 for couples, whereas former Commonwealth Public servants still pay tax (less 10% rebate) on their superannuation pensions and therefore their pensions still count as taxable income in calculating the \$80,000.

In view of the above facts, I request that urgent consideration br given to

- 1.Increasing qualifying amounts to correct years of non-action
- 2. Excluding all superannuation pensions from calculation of the qualifying amounts
