I write to make you aware that Labor has worked to establish a Senate Inquiry into the cost of living pressures facing older Australians.

On Monday, Liz Prime, the Labor candidate for Cowan, and I held a forum with seniors to discuss the spiralling cost of living.

At this forum, many seniors stated they are facing increases in staple grocery bills. In addition, the cost of petrol, transport, heating and housing have also increased.

You may be aware that the price of food has increased by 9% and the price of petrol by 17% in the last two years – that is why Kevin Rudd has persuaded the Howard Government to agree to the Senate Inquiry.
