Dear Senator Johnston,

Re: Inquiry into Regional and Remote Indigenous Communities

Thank you for your letter regarding the progress of the adoption of Opal fuel at Coles Express Halls Creek in Western Australia.

As you would already be aware, Coles Express was involved in the successful implementation of Opal fuel at three of our sites in Alice Springs in 2006. Because BP is the sole manufacturer of retail grade low aromatic fuel in Australia, our supplier, Shell, elected to source the fuel from BP and re-brand it Shell Low Aromatic in the event that customers were not familiar with the Opal brand.

Shell is aware of the Senate Select Committee's continuing inquiry into the wellbeing of regional and remote Indigenous communities in the Kimberley region. Accordingly, Shell will be in touch with their third party supplier of Opal fuel, BP, to discuss the matter and will be in contact with you shortly with a response.

Coles Express is supportive of the Federal Government's initiatives to reduce petrol sniffing and misuse of petroleum products in remote Australia by expanding the availability of Opal fuel, should supply become available.
