I recently received a letter from your committee secretary regarding the National Registration and Accreditation Scheme, specifically the recent exposure draft of the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law Bill 2009* (known as Bill B). The letter was not clear to me as to whether the default position was that all prior submissions would be considered as addressed unless they were re-submitted, or whether that was an opportunity instead to acknowledge any specific concerns that had been addressed in Bill B.

I wish to state clearly that Bill B has done nothing to address my concerns regarding the proposed Scheme, and I include once again my original submission - in its entirety - for consideration by the committee.
