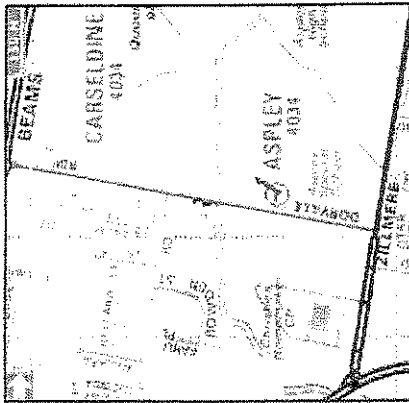
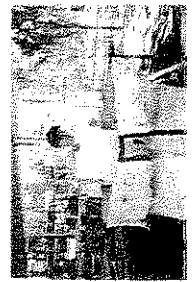

The centre promotes and practices environmental awareness, productive work that directly benefits their school and community.



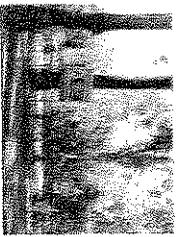
Work Undertaken at the centre includes

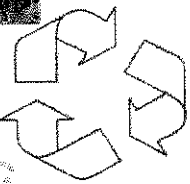
