## Re: Repeal of the Commonwealth Radioactive Waste Management Act

Since the announcement that Fishers Ridge was identified back in 2005 as one of the sites where the Radioactive dump was considered I have written to Ministers of whom most have had their assistance respond to my letters with no other information other than thanking me for my letter and they would get back to me on this matter.
