I am very concerned at the changes proposed that will exclude indigenous people from participating in the decisions made by the GBRMPAuthority.

- It will be a bad thing because their expertise and knowledge are useful,
- traditional owners of coastal land nearby will be directly affected by the decisions more than others,
- it is an insult that the original inhabitants who kept the reef in perfect condition for so many thousands of years are not permitted to assist in repairing the damage wrought by Europeans.
- Please reconsider the decision.
