## Dear Senator Eggleston

At the Senate Standing Committee on Environment, Communications, Information Technology and the Arts hearing on Tuesday 10 April 2007 the Department was asked to update the list of Shared Responsibility Agreements (SRAs), provided to the committee following the 9 February 2007 hearings, with the value of each SRA.

At the hearings on Friday 9 February 2007, in answering a question from Senator Webber on SRAs, I stated there were 25 SRAs relating to Indigenous arts and culture (page 6 of the Proof Hansard). The correct number of SRAs at the time was 24, not 25 as stated. The Department's response to the question on notice from Senator Webber on SRA's also listed 25 SRAs. The list included an SRA for which a DCITA contribution had been approved but which the Department subsequently discovered had not been finalised within the whole of government context. This SRA was signed on 18 May 2007.

Attached is an updated list detailing Indigenous arts and culture-related SRAs as at 18 May 2007, including the value of each SRA.

I regret that incorrect information was provided and would be grateful if these corrections could be drawn to the attention of members of the Committee
