

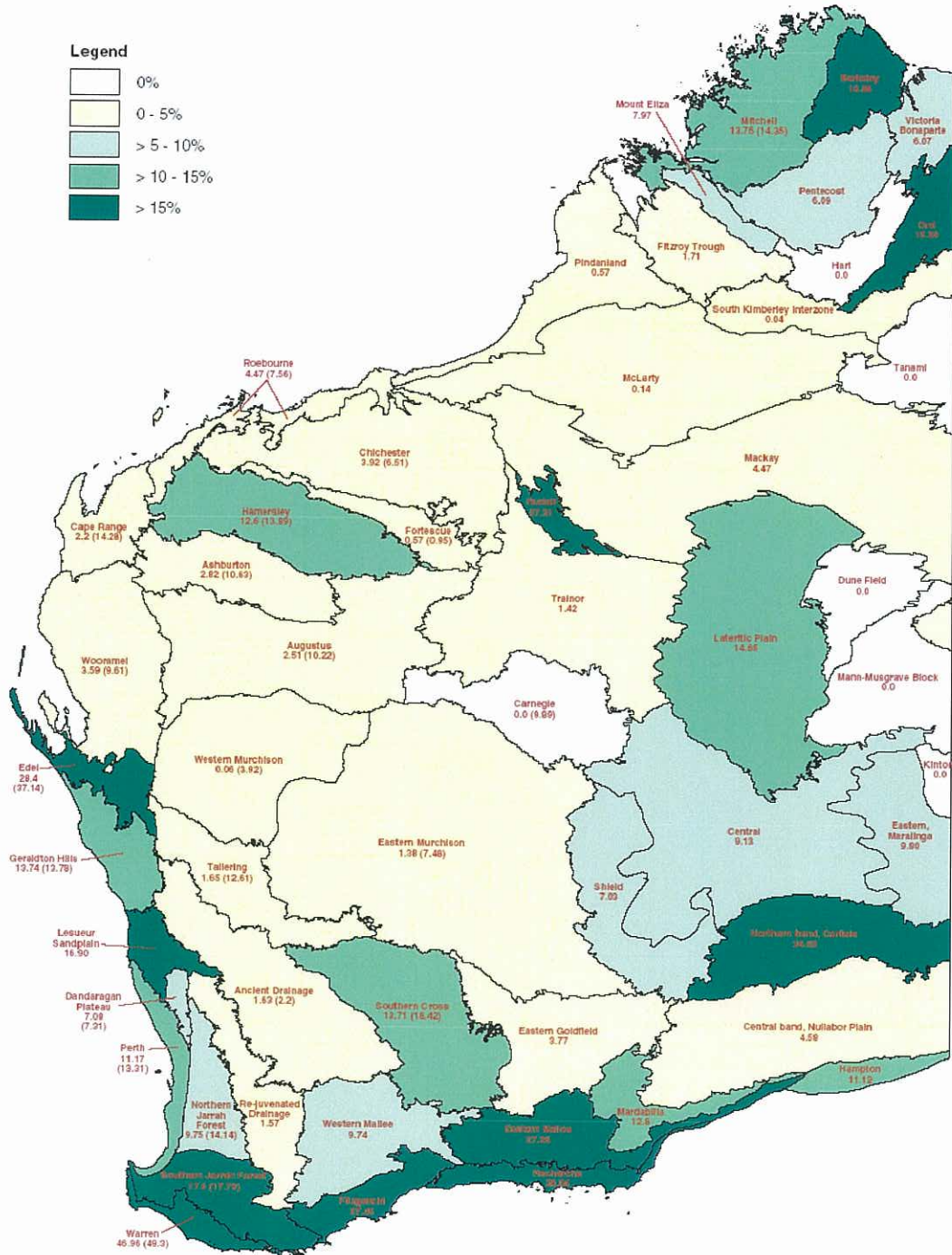

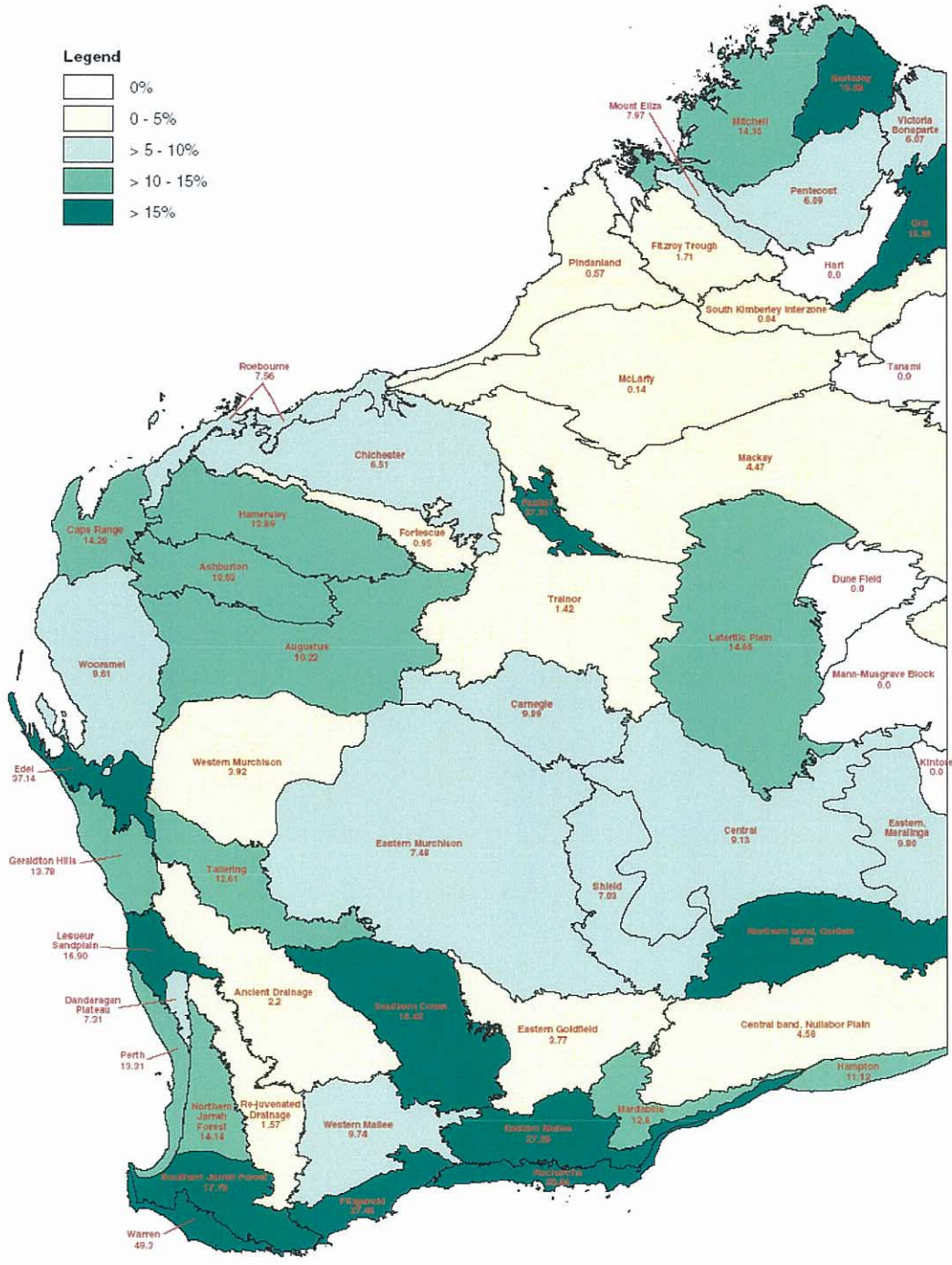

Areas presently in formal conservation reserves by bioregional province

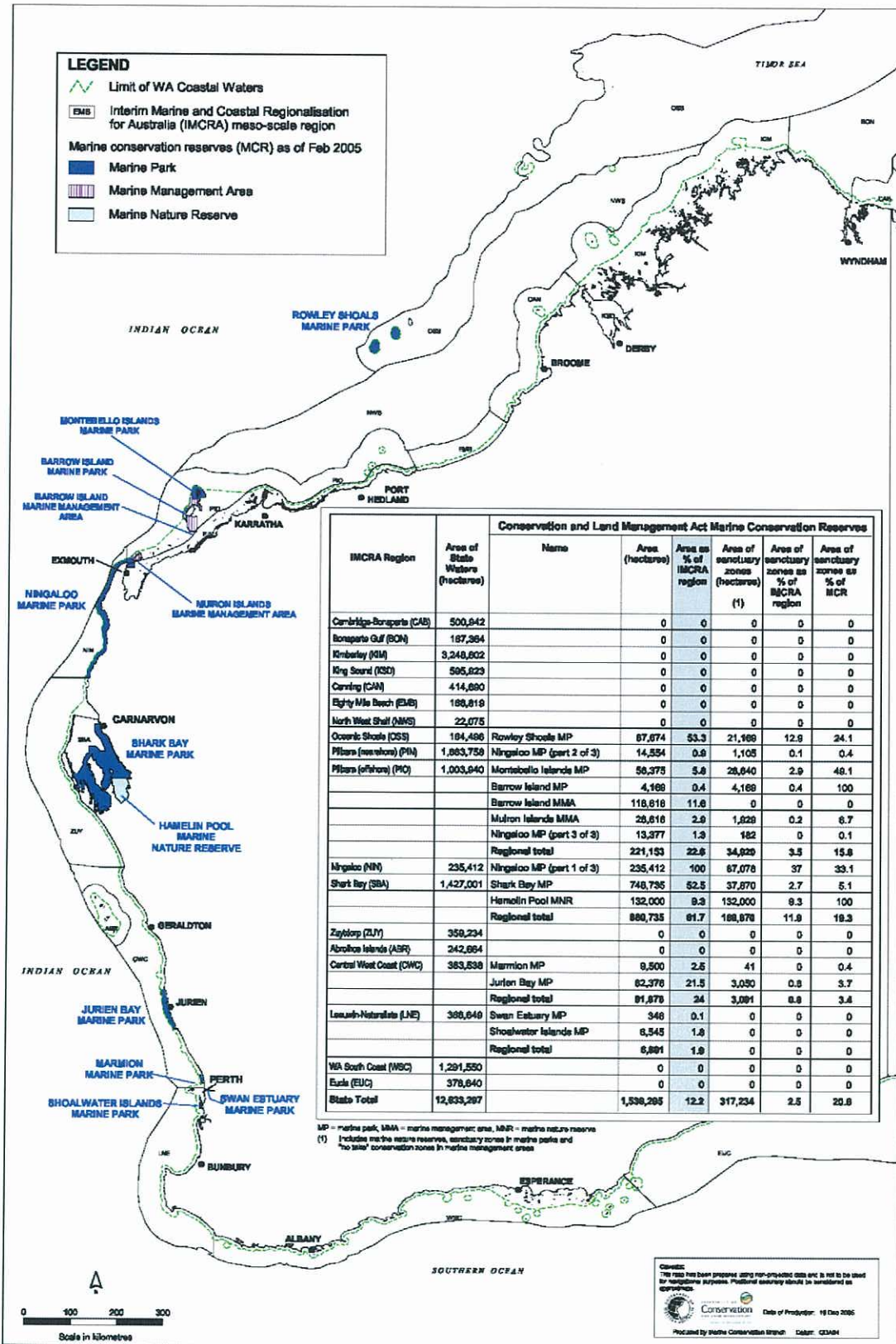

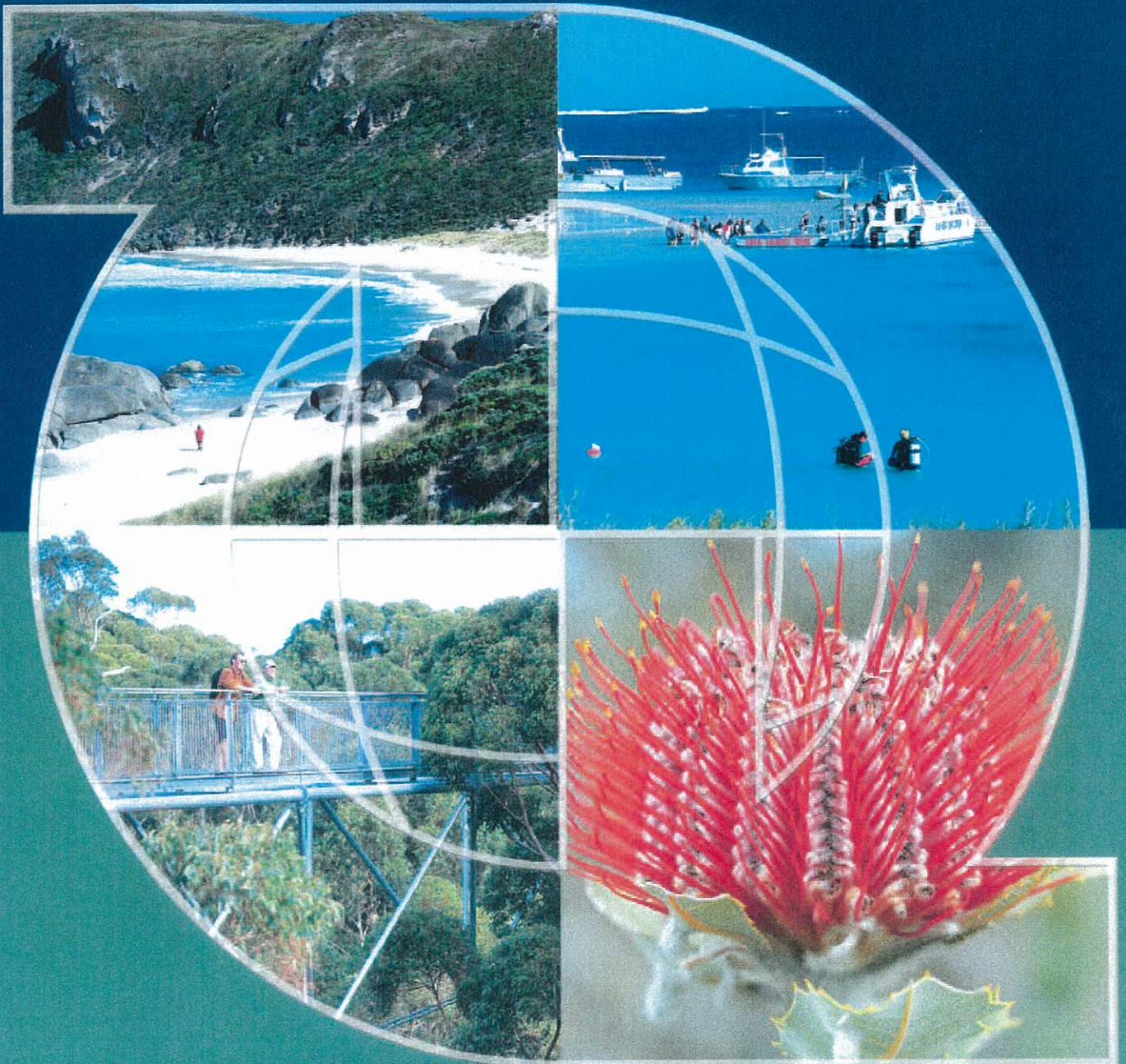

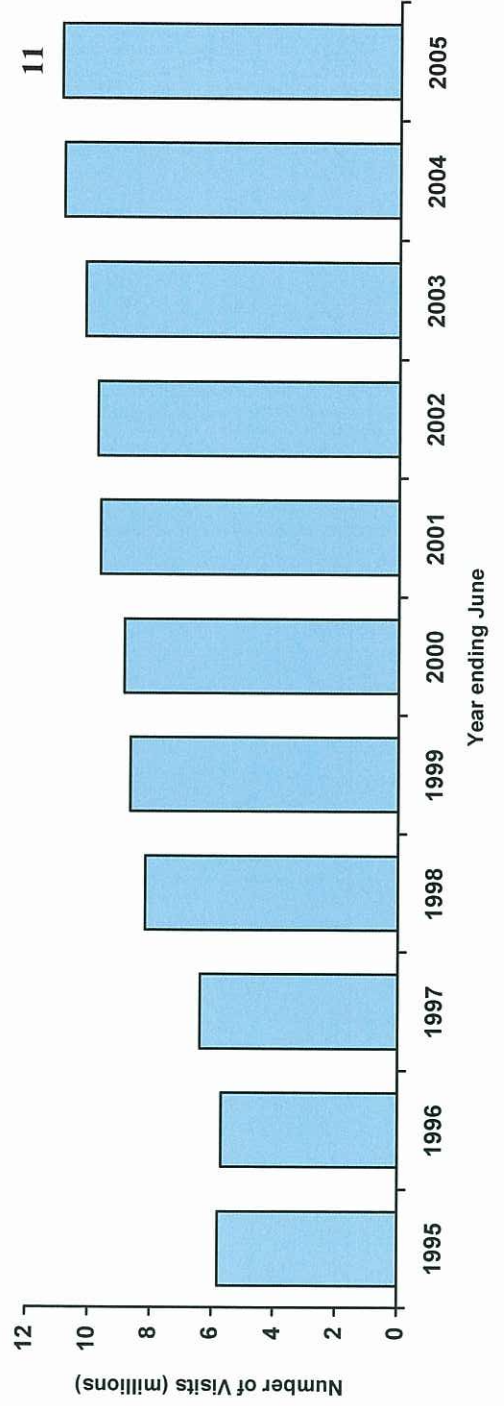

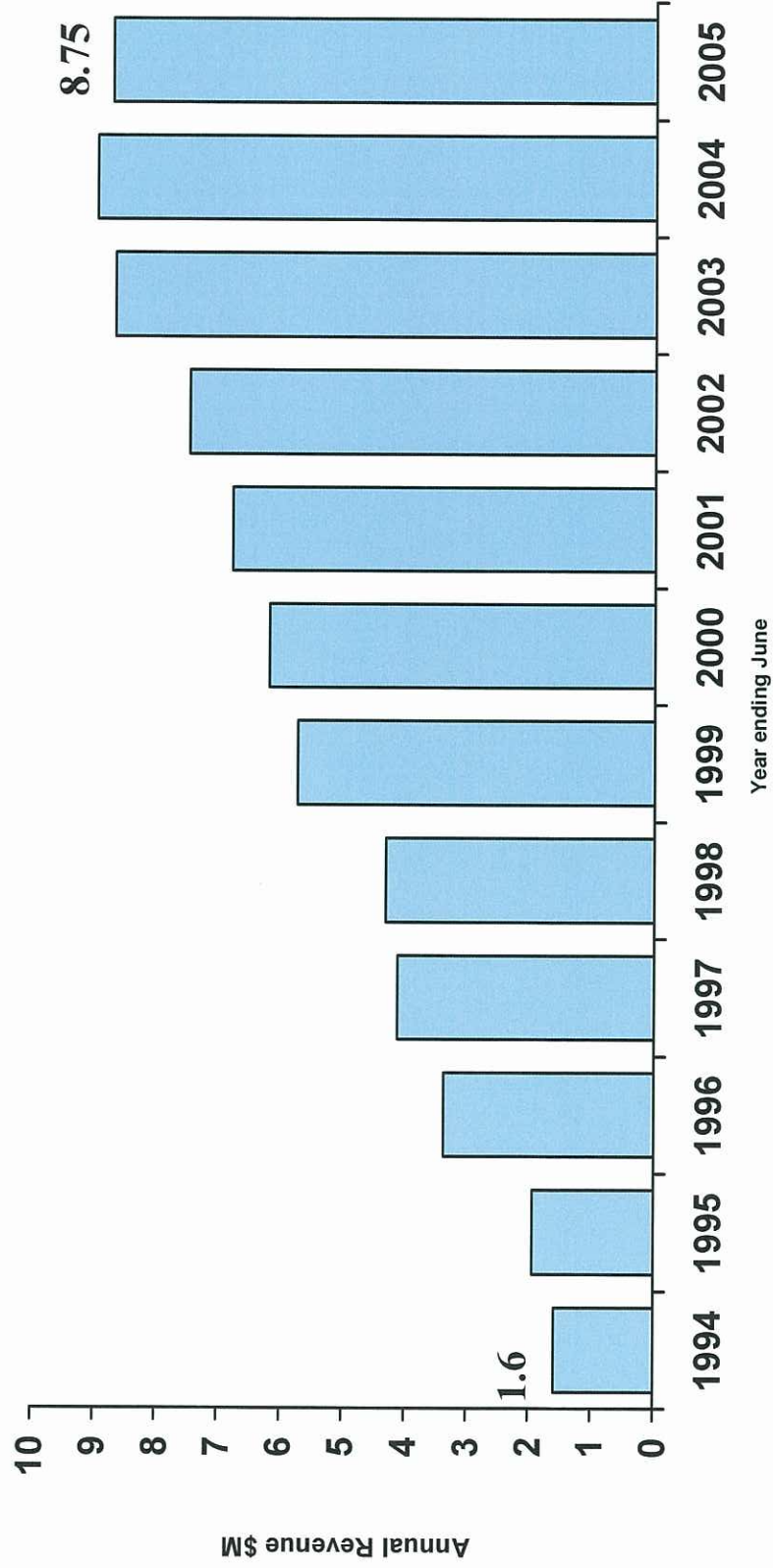

Number of visits recorded to CALM-managed lands and waters 1995-2005

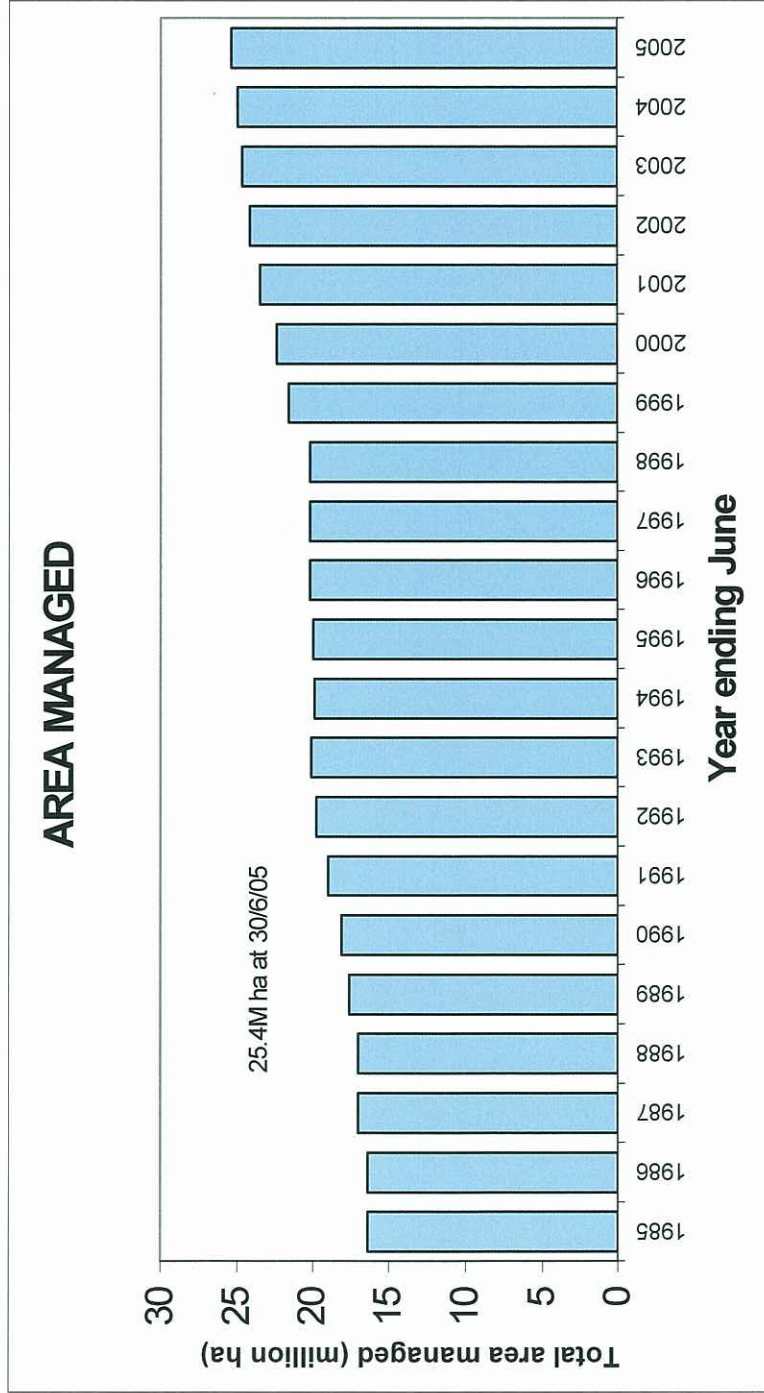

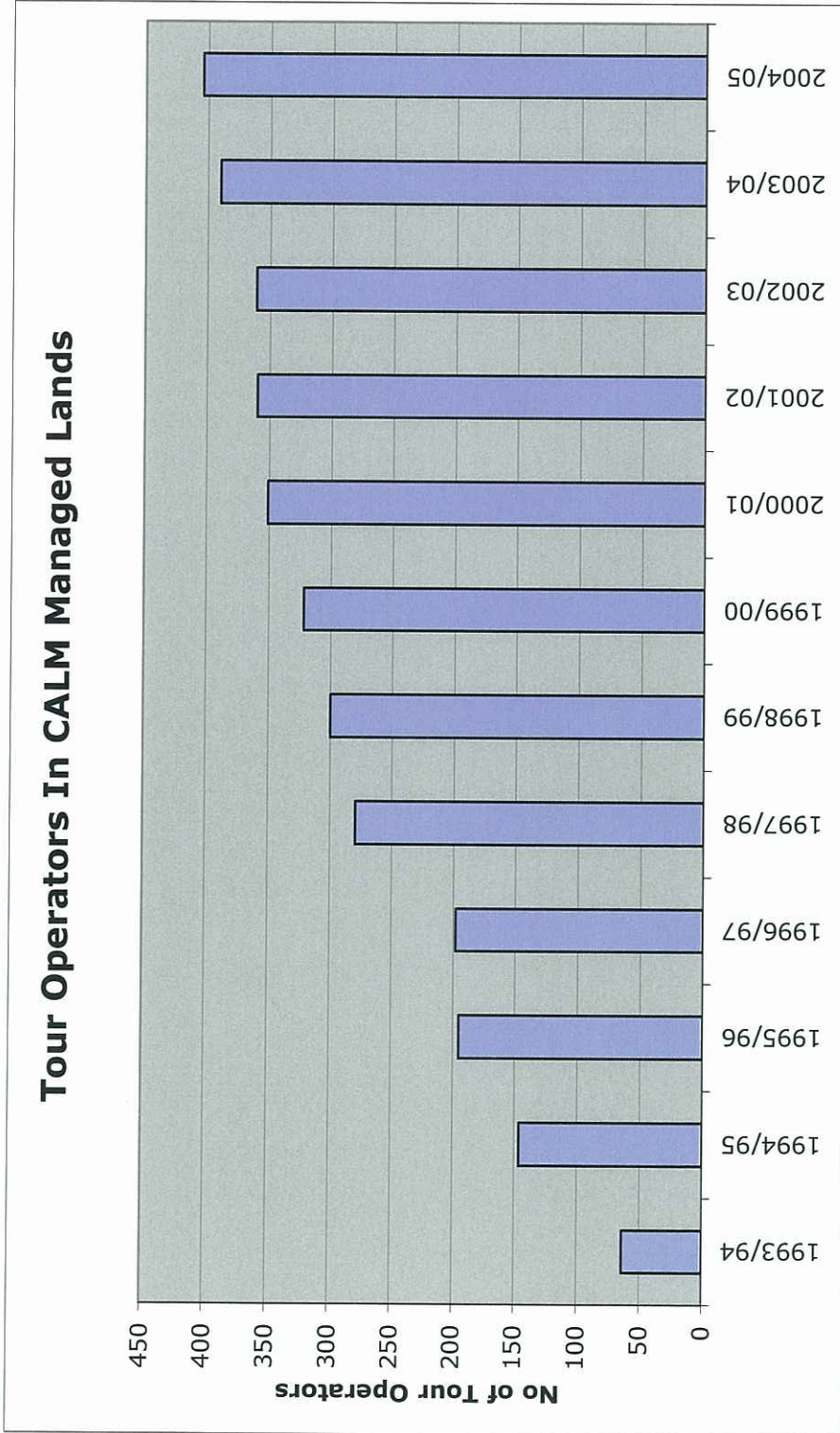
Recreation and Tourism Revenue



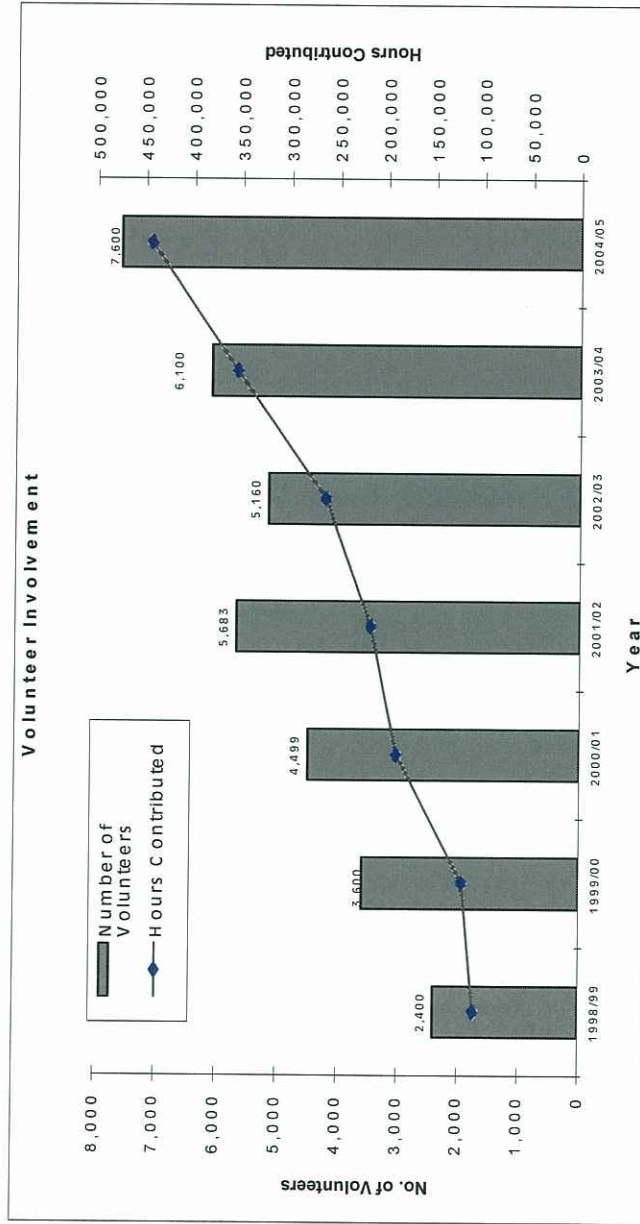

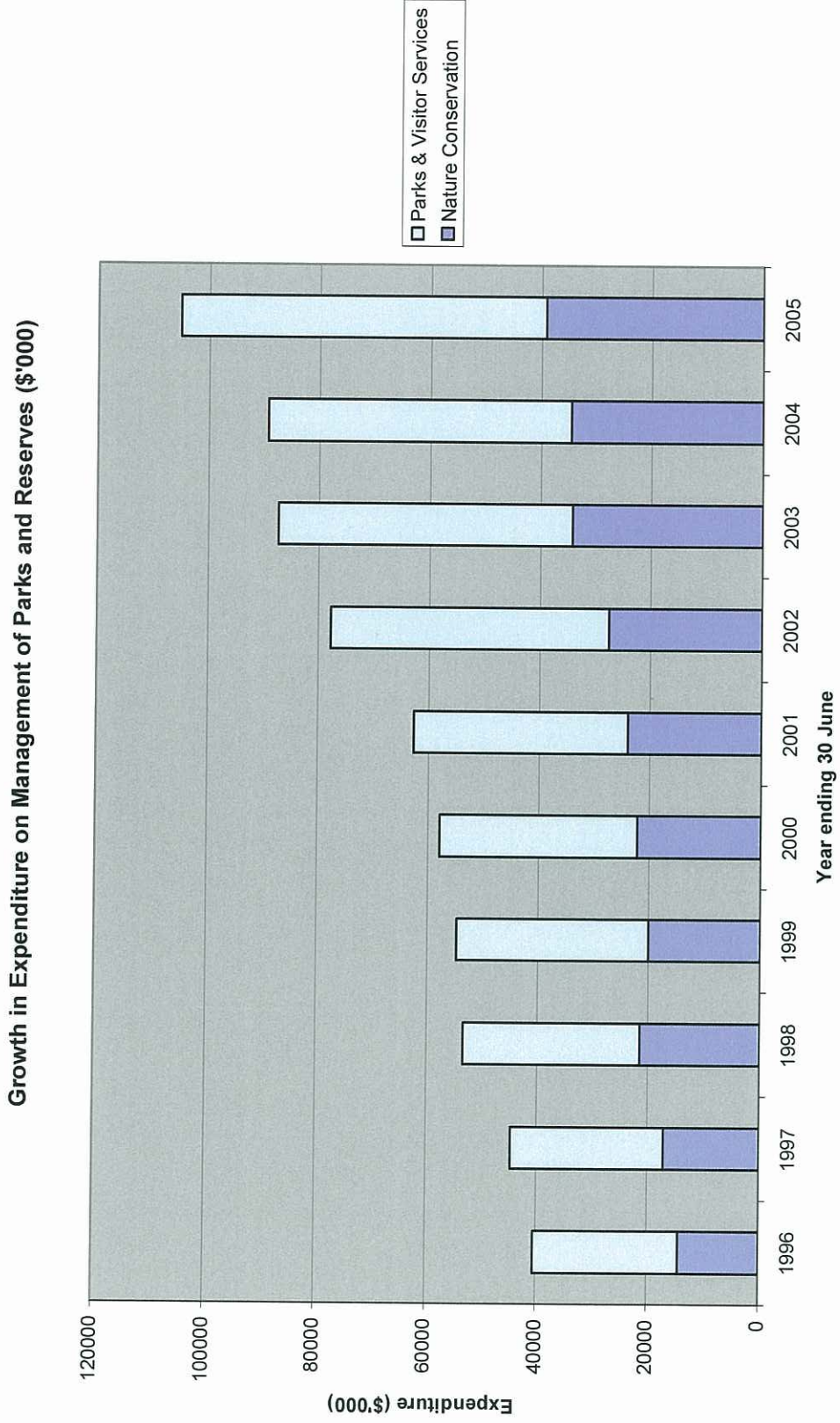

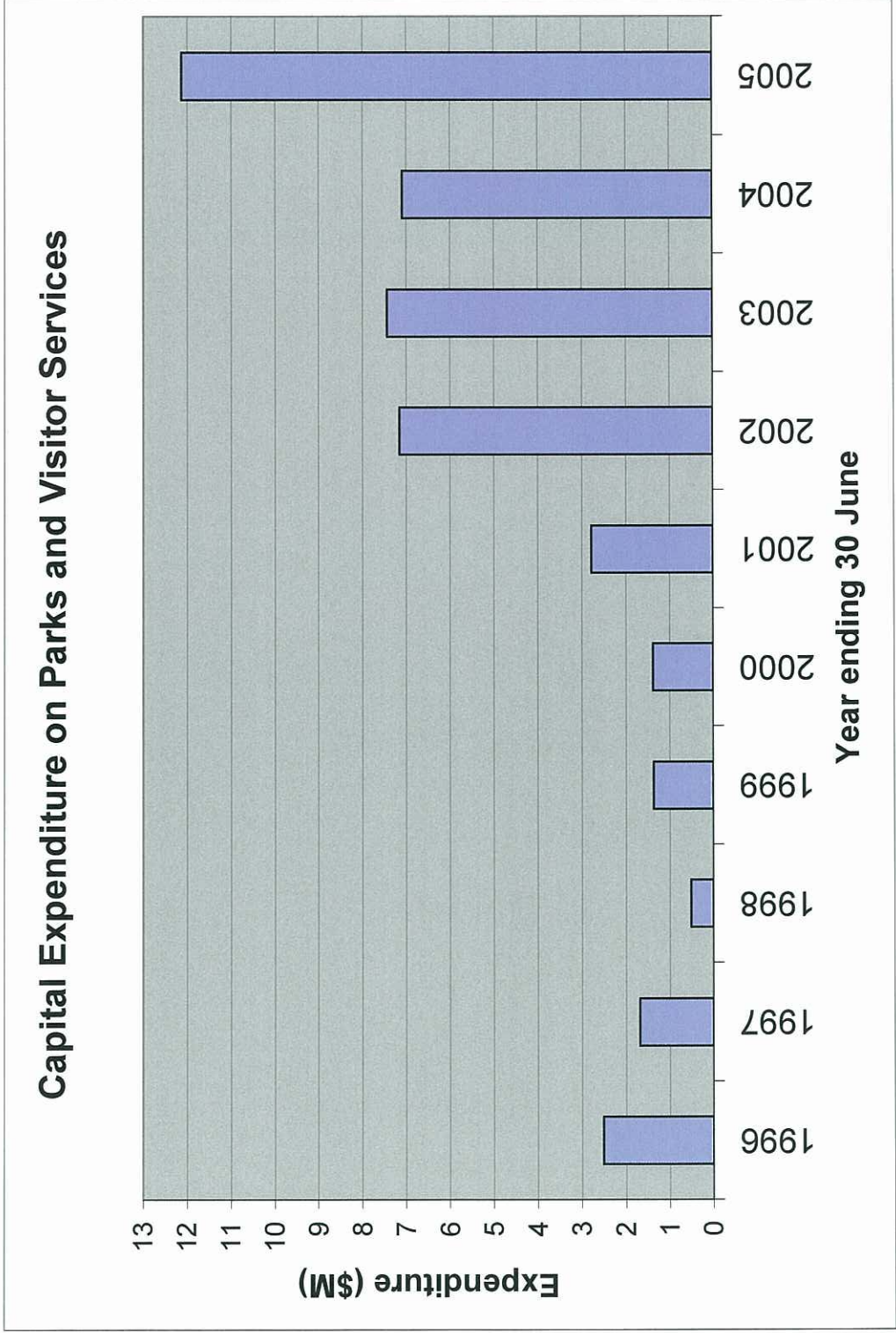

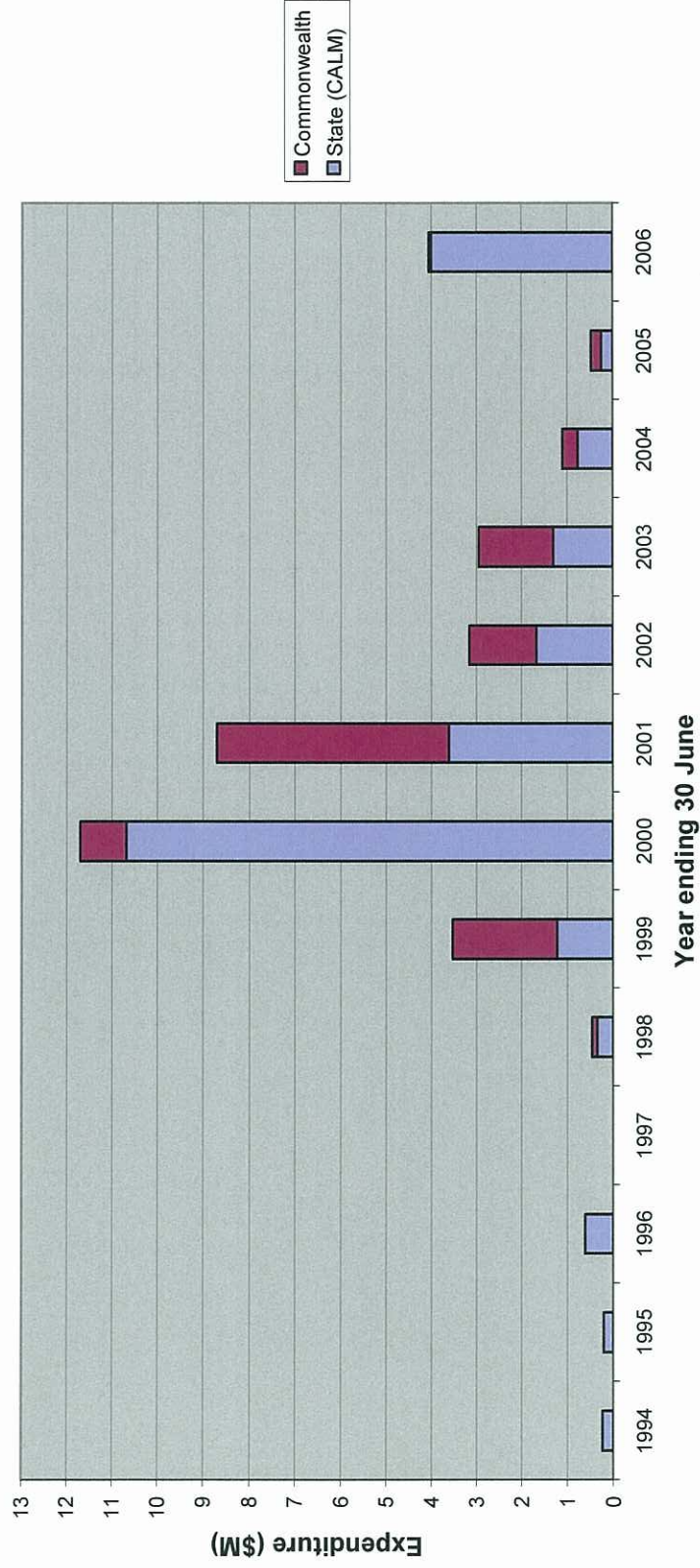
