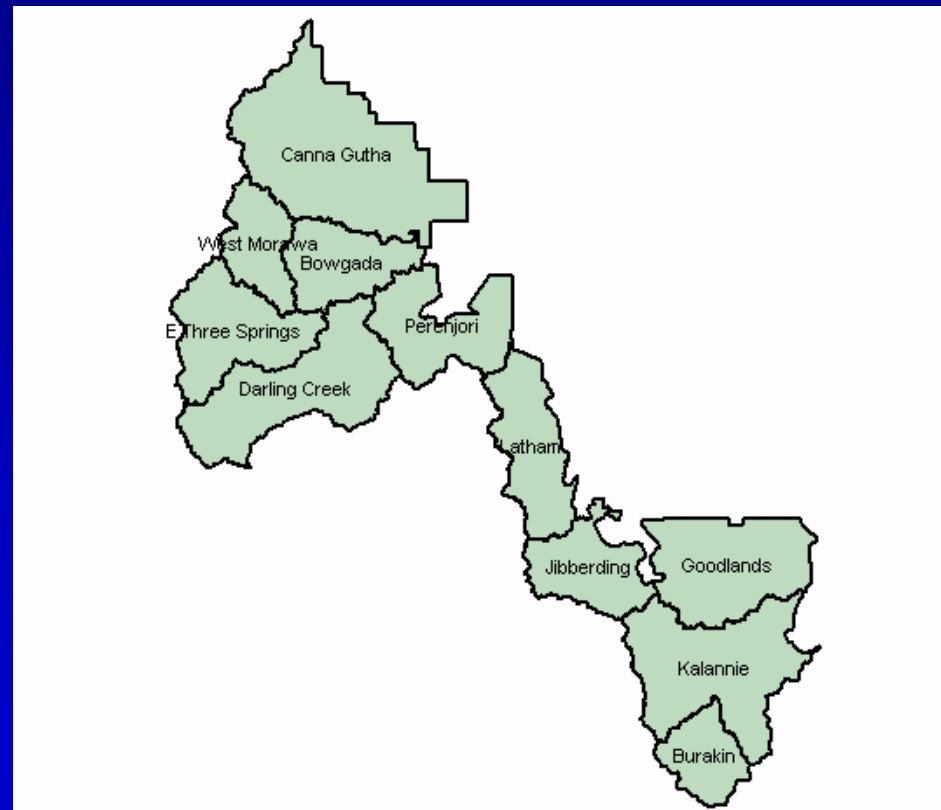


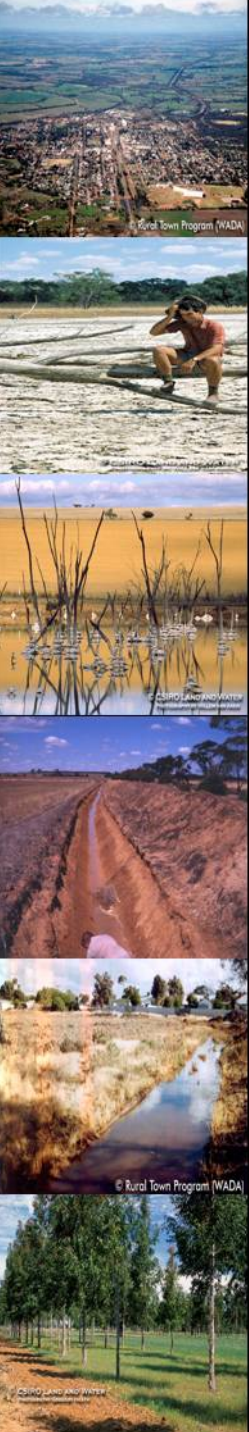
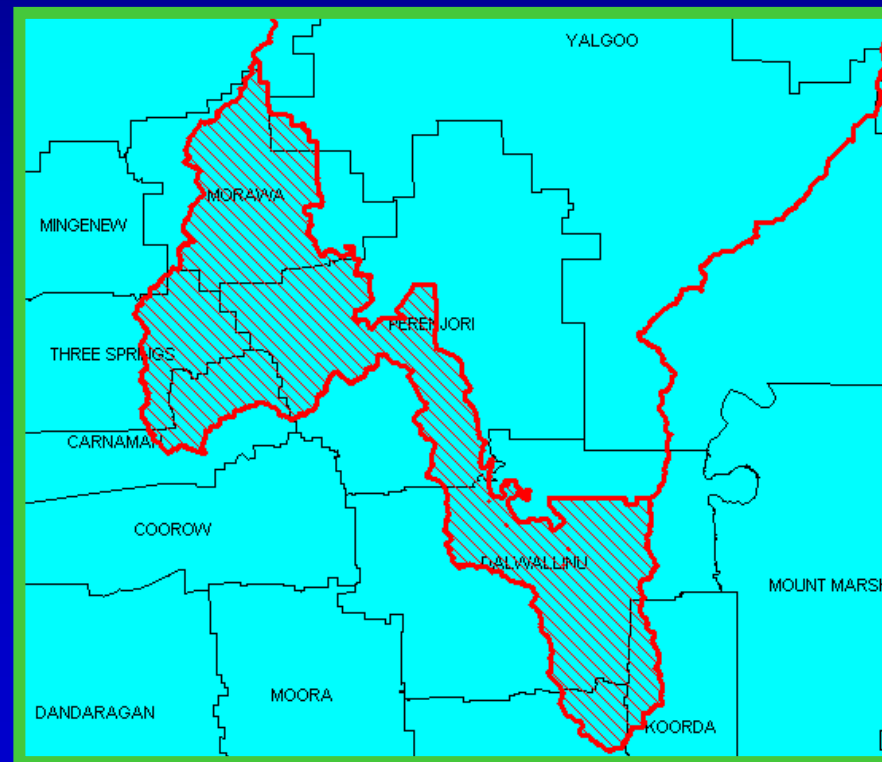
# The Formation of Zones

The amalgamation of smaller catchments into 11 management Zones provides a conduit for interaction between the community, staff and management committee.

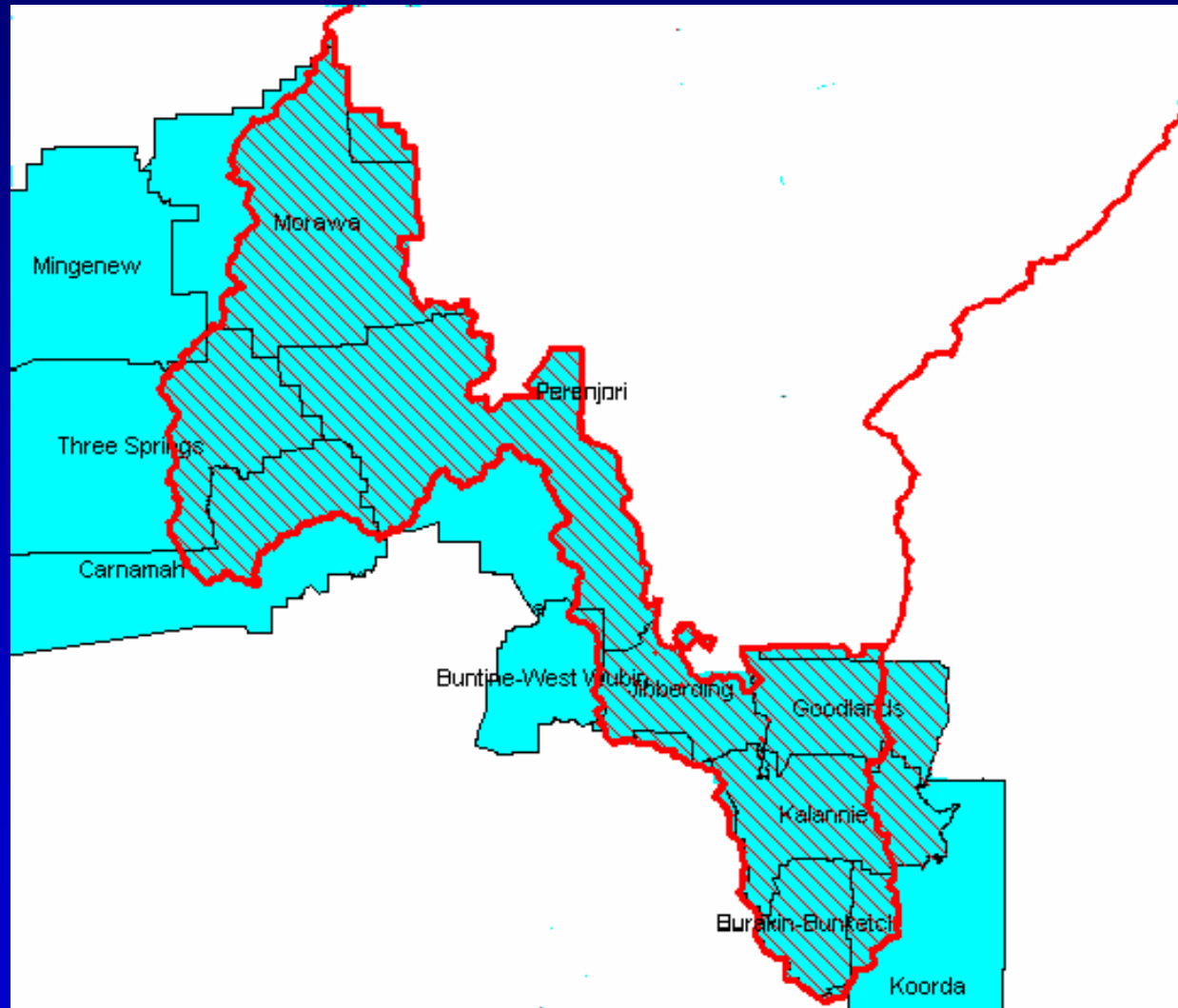
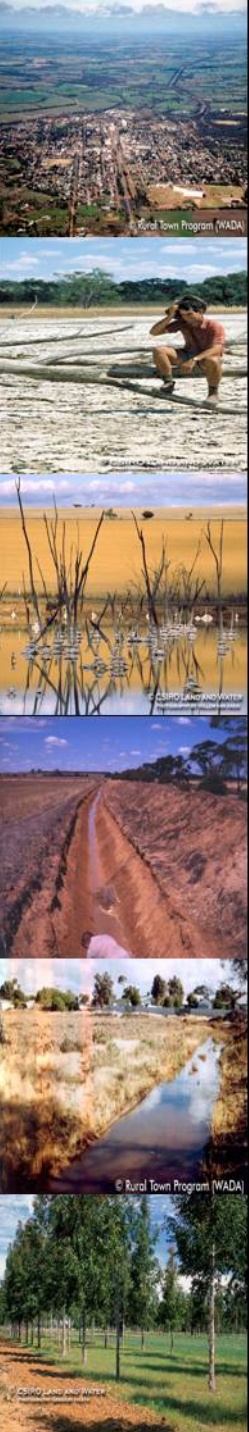


# Shire Land Holdings in the Yarra Yarra Sub Region

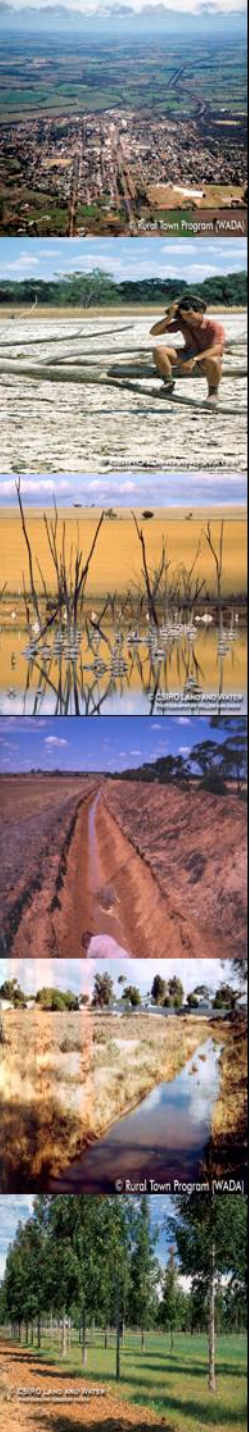
