

The Federal Government has NOT been given a mandate to dump nuclear waste anywhere, let alone the NT. Radiation facts:- The most common forms of ionizing radiation are alpha and beta particles, or gamma or X-rays. Any living tissue can be damaged by ionizing radiation. It is the equivalent of an average person receiving 2 chest X-rays an hour.
