Dear Madam, Please refer to my email of 20/11/05 requesting
approval of late submission on above Bill.

I object strongly to above Bill, especially as your
Govt tried to impose such a dump on S.A. and now
for no good reason (as before) on our next-door
neighbours, the people and environment of N.T. My
reasons are below:

1. Overriding legislation by Climate Proactive is hardly democracy
