Inquiry into the effects of climate change on training and employment needs

In this submission I wish to comment in relation to the Australian vocational education and training (VET) sector. VET in Australia can be broadly characterised as being industry led. This means that the system is intended to provide individuals with skills and competencies that meet the needs of industry. The most important element of the system to achieve this aim comprises the training packages that are developed by industry skills councils on behalf of industry more broadly. Each training package contains a set of units which list the competencies that those being trained are expected to achieve, and are constantly being revised to take account of the evolving needs of industry. A list of the skills industry councils and the training packages is at attachment A.

I argue that the way the VET system should deal with the effects of climate change is no different from the way it should deal with any other sort of structural change in the economy. The VET system needs to respond to the changing requirements of industry, and if the VET system remains focused on that then there is no specific need for action on climate change. In fact, there is direct evidence that this is happening. The example I use is that in recent years there have been numerous units designed around the 'sustainability' as a direct result of the way industry is adapting to new environmental priorities. Examples of such units are listed in attachment B.

In recent years there has been some research done on the issue of sustainability, of which climate change is a key element. In particular, I draw your attention to a book due to be published by Springer in November.

I contributed a final synthesis chapter, in which I point to the ideological zeal that many bring to the topic and argue that it would be better for the VET sector to focus on meeting industry's needs than to see VET as a crusader for sustainability. Sustainability issues will directly affect economic structures and the way industries operate, and VET would be contributing very significantly to the sustainability cause if it can be flexible in the competencies it teaches. That is, VET needs to focus on meeting industry's needs rather than sustainability as such.

Society is becoming increasingly aware of the need for education to play a key role in integrating knowledge and understanding about sustainability into practical, vocational skills which can be used in the workplace. Education for sustainability is now a widely accepted concept which seeks to promote and develop sustainability skills and awareness throughout a learner's educational pathway. This report shows that the vocational education and training (VET) sector has a key role to play in promoting sustainability education by incorporating these skills into training packages. However, significant barriers exist to implementation, including the lack of a shared national vision and adequate resources. The report concludes with suggestions to encourage the adoption of education for sustainability in VET policy and practice
