Terrorist attacks since 11 September

Attacks include:

- 13 December 2001 - New Delhi –attack on Indian Parliament - 14 killed
- 22 January 2002 - Calcutta –attack on US cultural centre - 5 killed, 13 injured
- 17 March 2002 – Islamabad – grenade attack on Protestant church - 5 killed, 40 injured
- 20 March 2002 - Lima, Peru - car bomb near US Embassy - 9 killed, 32 injured
- 11 April 2002 - Djerba, Tunisia – truck bomb at synagogue - 16 killed, 26 injured
- 8 May 2002 - Karachi – car bomb outside Sheraton hotel - 12 killed, 19 injured
- 14 June 2002 - Karachi – car bomb near US Consulate and Marriott Hotel - 11 killed, 51 injured
- 5 August 2002 - Murree, Pakistan – attack on Christian school - 5 killed
- 6 October 2002 - Coast of Yemen – bombing of French oil tanker Limburg - 1 killed, 4 injured
- 12 October 2002 - Bali – bombing of Paddy's Bar and Sari Club in Bali - 202 killed
- 24 October 2002 - Moscow – hostage taking at theatre - 90 killed
- 28 October 2002 - Amman – US diplomat assassinated
- 28 November 2002 - Mombassa hotel bombing – 13 killed, 80 injured and rocket launch against El Al aircraft
- 5 December 2002 - Makassar, Indonesia – McDonald's outlet bombed – 3 killed, 11 injured
- 4 March 2003 - Davao Airport, southern Philippines – bombing - 22 killed, 150 injured
- 2 April 2003 - Davao Wharf, southern Philippines – bombing - 16 killed, 50 injured
- 12 May 2003 - Riyadh - housing compounds bombed – 29 killed, 160 injured
- 16 May 2003 – Casablanca – series of bombings – 41 killed
- 5 July 2003 - Moscow– rock concert bombing – 14 killed, 60 injured
- 5 August 2003 - Jakarta – Marriott Hotel – 11 killed, 144 injured
- 8 November 2003 - Riyadh – housing compounds – 17 killed, 100 injured
- 15 November 2003 – Istanbul – Synagogue attacks – 23 killed, 300 injured
- 20 November 2003 - Istanbul – British Consulate and HSBC Bank – 27 killed, 450 injured
