### DIMBULAH TOWN WATER SUPPLY

Consumers and landowners are hereby advised that the level of service provided by the Dimbulah Town Water Supply does not meet the minimum guidelines with respect to Fire Fighting as published by the Department of Natural Resources and Mining for the Planning and Design of Urban Water Supply Schemes. Upgrading of the scheme at this time to meet fire fighting guidelines is considered to be beyond the financial resources available for the Dimbulah Water Supply Scheme. Accordingly, Council suggests that individuals and businesses make an assessment, or engage an appropriately qualified person to make an assessment, of fire protection services that are required and/or are appropriate for their property and consider what fire fighting aids should be installed to protect their premises.
