2. Kimberley Aboriginal Pastoralists Association: Funding approved: \$317,130 out of a project value of \$616,130. A key partner, ILC, withdrew funding in October 2004 and after investigation of the circumstances and project milestone report examination by DOTARS a decision was made to withdraw SR funding. The Kimberley Aboriginal Pastoralists Association was advised of DOTARS decision by letter dated 19th November 2004.

3. The SONA Guidelines in fact are included in the Regional Partnerships Internal Procedures Manual which Mr Durant acknowledged receiving from the Department on March 31st, 2005.
