SUBMITTING MY OBJECTION TO THE PROPOSED PLEBISCITE ON A REPUBLIC

Her Majesty's Government under the Australian Constitutional Monarchy finds my undivided support. I have, with great concern, taken notice of a bill calling for a plebiscite on the question of a change to a republic. The plebiscite will cost in excess of an estimated 10 million dollars and deal with a question already decided upon during the 1999 Republic Referendum – in favour of retaining the Monarchy.

Since the bill has been referred to your committee, please note my whole-hearted objection to this proposal, on the grounds of maintaining the constitutional and financial integrity of our country.
