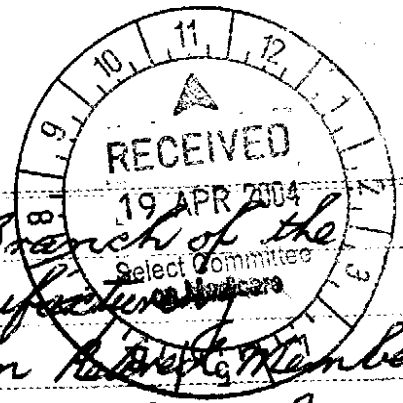

Dear People,

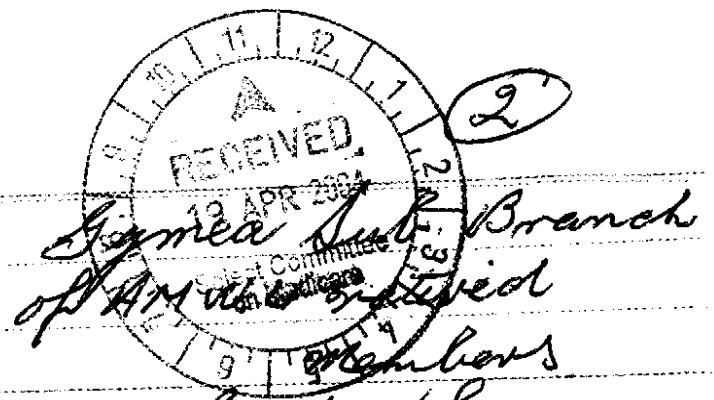
You are our
