GLADSTONE FUEL PRICES.

Where does our fuel come from? Does it come from Singapore refineries as crude oil Or as refined fuel? Does it go to Brisbane first or delivered to storage depots on Qld coastline. We are supposed to get our fuel by ship. How many fuel storage depots are there on QLD's east coast?

Why do Capital cities get cheaper fuel 2 days a week when country areas do not? Are these minimum prices and who pays for this, the oil Companies or the service stations? Why does the price rise dramatically?

Why are we paying up to 10cents a litre or more than Brisbane? Why are some country areas which are supplied from Gladstone are similar prices to us, sometimes less. Rockhampton and Emerald.

Boyne Island and Mt Larcom are up to 6cents a litre cheaper but the fuel comes from here.

Towns such as Gympie, Kingaroy, Atherton, Roma, Childers, Gin Gin are cheaper than large towns such as Gladstone, Bundaberg, Rockhampton.

Why can Choice Petroleum sell fuel 4 cents a litre cheaper when they are supplied by Mobil.

Do State Government pay excise and GST on their fuel. Especially when competing Against private enterprise for long distance passenger and freight work?

Rumours abound that Toll Holdings were paying 66to 80 cents a litre for diesel When everyone else was paying up to 1.80 cents a litre.

Why has the price of motor oils risen possibly 25% when the price of a barrel of oil has fallen by 60%.

How can businesses who run vehicles as part of their business plan their charges when the price of fuel in capital cities varies every few days?
