I am very depressed nowadays about my family's whereabouts and don't know whether they are in good spirit. It is causing me mental anguish and anxiety. American invaders are still surrounding Kabul rather than other parts of the country. I don't know when my area will be saved to return.

During Easter holidays, we had protest outside of our detention but we were not able to see them either to see them. So I depressively climbed up to the pole ~~and~~ intend to stimulate them but as soon as I climbed down I was attacked by A.C.M security Guards and assaulted by A.C.M guards which contributed me bruising and back pain and thereafter I was placed to Isolation and no any medical access given to me even I insisted for medical attention.

As you said, you have raised some money for refugee if you can ask someone to find me a computer, it would be great help while I am suffering here. I am grateful for your parcel which I have received. Better environments are so harsh and oppressive to cop. Please could you send me your picture and phone number if you don't mind.

I am happy to receive letter from you and always pray for your well-being. So I sign off for now
