- a. our opinion that this Bill undermines Australia's international obligations under the Convention for the Status of Refugees (The Refugee Convention);
- b. our concern that this Bill in the context of the fact that Australia is a nation of "boatpeople" seriously undermines our National character as a nation;
- c. our concern that this Bill very seriously erodes any gains to the humane and peaceful treatment of refugees, including the assessment of their asylum applications as a result of the recent commitments given to the socalled Georgiou/Moylan group;
- d. our concern that this Bill embodies what may well be construed at a future date a deliberate "persecution of a distinct group of the world population of migrants that is 'boat people'" in the context of International law.
