There has been minimal involvement by the ACT Government in native title issues in the past. Only three native title claims have been brought before the Federal Court in the ACT and to date no determination has been made that any native title rights exist in the area.

The common law and the Native Title Act 1993 probably together extinguished native title over large parts of the land of the ACT.

in relation to the current inquiry, there is a need for any system that is put in place to encourage open communication, early information exchange and transparency when dealing with Indigenous people and representative bodies.

I look forward to the final report from the inquiry in due course.
