I disagree that it is in the best interests of families and the community to modify the Marriage Act.

The Marriage Amendment Bill 2004, encompasses what we have always known: that marriage is "between one man and one woman, to the exclusion of all others, voluntarily entered into for life".

I believe that:

- Marriage between a man and a woman support the family and is the foundation of society.
- The best place to raise a family is in a family-based traditional marriage.
- Opening marriage to other relationships devalues the social standing of marriage.

I ask that you REJECT this Bill.
