Supplementary Submission #2 to the Senate Select Committee on Mental Health by Bio-Balance Health Association Inc.

Attached for consideration by the Senate Select Committee on Mental Health.is a further submission supplementary to the previous Bio-Balance Health Association submissions (Submission #378 and #378A)

This supplementary submission is a just-completed report by Dr Richard Stuckey, the first Australian medical practitioner trained in the techniques for treatment of mental and behavioural disorders developed by Health Research Institute – Pfeiffer Treatment Center (HRI-PTC), which were the primary focus of our first submission (Sub. #378). Dr William Walsh, founder and Chief Scientist of HRI-PTC, trained Dr Stuckey on Dr Walsh's first visit to Australia in April 2004. The report, titled 12 Months with Pfeiffer, comprises the first systematic application of the Pfeiffer treatment protocols in Australia and provides an analysis of treatment outcomes for the first twelvemonth period for the first 80 patients treated by Dr Stuckey using Pfeiffer protocols, together with illustrative case studies from this group of patients

The report is presented in the form of a Power Point presentation that has been prepared by Dr Stuckey for a Pfeiffer Conference that will take place in Sydney during the Pfeiffer Outreach Clinic visit to Sydney in February 2006. The file contains some biochemical terms and Pfeiffer protocol concepts that may not be familiar to Select Committee members. Dr Stuckey will be present with other Bio-Balance Health Association representatives at the Select Committee hearing on 2 February 2006 and will be pleased to briefly explain these terms to Committee members at that time and to elaborate on the material contained in the report as requested by the Committee.
