Unfortunately we have not had time to prepare a detailed submission. However, I attach a copy of our submission made in 2002 to the NSW Parliament Select Committee on Mental Health. If anything, it has changed for the worse as funding and staffing levels have not kept pace with the demand for services. We continue to have many clients incarcerated in correctional centres when they would be more appropriately managed in psychiatric facilities.
