TERMS OF REFERENCE

The following matter was referred to the Rural and Regional Affairs and Transport References Committee for inquiry and report:

The further examination of the National OJD Program with particular reference to:

- (a) the timetable for the National OJD Program to combat OJD;
- (b) the likely cost of the isolation and elimination of OJD from the Australian sheep flock;
- (c) the extent and nature of any research being conducted in relation to OJD testing techniques and/or possible vaccines to treat OJD; and
- (d) the respective contribution of government and industry that will be required to fund the National OJD Program.
