Dear Sir. I felt disappointed when I read the Bill of yours 12 Dec 2002.

I do not believe an EWA is desirable or legitimate for the following reasons.

1. The Monopoly Contravenes the TPA (Cth) 1974 by virtue of it having no net benefit that is not in the public interest.
  2. The S51 (TPA) Exemption is null and void (Statutory Exemptions) ACCC.
  3. We already have the Export Control Act and Customs Act.
  4. The Monopoly is being used as a weapon of Foreign Policy and also a Weapon of War. We are owed \$200 million by the Govt since 1992: pursuant.
  5. Why should our small communities pay for this monopoly when really a few vested interests want it. The growers want choice like Victorian Barley - No. one would return to a barley monopoly.
