## Inquiry into the Wheat Marketing Amendment Bill 2002

This is a time when the WA Grain Growing Industry must stand united. Directors of AWB and CBH/Grain Pool of WA need to have a look back over the last 3 years to see what happens when they try to enter the highflying corporate world. Our industry basically hasn't changed, and therefore we need little structural change, commonsense being the main ingredient.

Directors need to realise that they are there for the growers. They are not there to be brainwashed by executives who want to build up empires. The memory of how one director and shareholders managed to defeat privatization of CBH is fresh in our memories and getting clearer
