

Dear Committee Secretary


I received a letter from Steve Crammas MP
in relation to submissions to the Senate Inquiry
regarding the Adelaide Airport.

I have written letters and personally spoken to
Steve about my concerns regarding Aircraft noise
around the western Suburbs, in the last 2 or so years.
I have also written letters to the Transport Minister
Local and state MPs including the Premier Mike Rann
the Adelaide Airport Manager and the local Member.
I have also written and spoken to Management at
Australian Air Service on many occasions.

The problems that myself, family and many other
residents around Henley Beach and other suburbs
around Adelaide are experiencing, are noise coming
from light Aircraft, single & twin propeller, helicopters
I have been living in Henley Beach area for
many years and never had any issues with Aircraft
noise.

I started to notice an increase in light Aircraft
and helicopters flying overhead 3 years ago and it
got to the point where the situation became
unbearable at times and forced me to bring this
to the attention of the Authorities.

These Light Aircraft & Helicopters seem to have total
freedom to fly across residential suburbs at any
time of day & night. The sound they force through
the air travels a long way and it is very penetrative,
vibrating, and loud at times, especially when they
are flying low altitudes and using full throttle.



My Family and myself have been woken up many times between the hours of 11pm to 6am and the other night around 2am we were woken up by the sound of a Helicopter which was flying low as the sound was aggressive & loud.

Why is there controls for large jets and none for light Aircraft.

This "free" movement of light Aircraft has been imposed on us without public consultation and is an invasion.

I notice a lot of these light Aircraft are just flying over the city, Joy riding, learning to fly etc. If there are restrictions for jets etc, cars, trucks and anything else that disturbs the peace & safety of citizens, then the same laws should be applied for these aircraft.

I have been told by Airservices Australia that Herley Beach is close to a flight path, but if it was just the flight path, it would be half as bad. Herley Beach seems to be a crossroad and I am sure the situation to control this noise pollution can be possible without justifying this harassment. Helicopter movement can be reduced as I'm sure they are not all flying to attend emergencies or assist Police.

Having a Helicopter hovering over your house when you are asleep is not justified in my opinion. Police can deal with a situation with patrol cars.

All that I am asking, and I'm sure many other residents of Adelaide' is to look into these noise issues and produce a more balanced plan of action.

All services Australia has been very disappointing for me as they have not really addressed these issues, what is the point of having a Service to call for ~~Airport~~ complaints when the Services just registers the calls and does nothing else.
