State Member for Noosa, wish to make a joint submission to the upcoming Senate Inquiry into the Qld Traveston Dam Proposal. We wish to offer direct evidence that the Beattie Government's Traveston Dam proposal was not based on any credible research into water management nor on credible environmental and economic grounds, but instead was purely a cynical exercise in political expedience because of the then upcoming 2006 state election. In other words the dam site was chosen purely for political reasons to help win the election.
