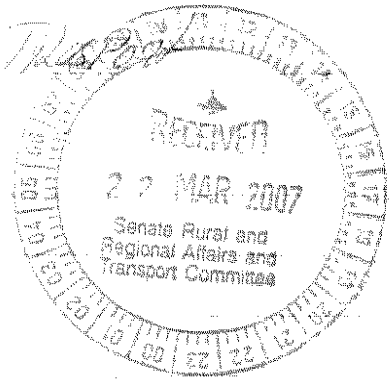

We have been running a fencing business

had been accepted. These were all cancelled
within a week of the announcement of the proposed

This has caused us extreme hardship
financially and mentally. We are not
able to help to look for handpays to
cover our bills, but had to get a lifeline
to pay our Electricity accounts.
