My wife was in UK around the time of the Mad Cow disease and she could not donate blood for ten years in case she had inadvertently eaten contaminated meat, so what does that tell us?

I am very concerned about any type of food coming into Australia from any country where we have little or no control of how it is grown, handled or packaged.

This will affect all Australians, not just farmers.
