Animal-derived food products

I am writing to bring to your attention the concerns of Hunter Animal Watch about the lack of standards in food labelling. As an animal welfare organisation, and as consumers ourselves, we find the present situation frustrating.

We would like to be confident that when we buy a food product labelled "free range" it actually is, and that the standards applied for both animal welfare and food quality, are stringent. Other terms which are often used are "bred free range", biodynamic", "organic", and so on.

Of major concern to us is the lack of national standards. We do not believe that this important issue can be left in the hands of state governments as consumers cannot rely that a term used in one state is backed by precisely the same standards in another. The same applies to animal welfare laws. To achieve reliable outcomes, national laws are necessary.

We ask that the Committee work to reform legislation and regulation in regard to food labelling, branding and marketing so that consumers are confident that high standards back the products they purchase and that the highest animal welfare standards apply nationally.

We share the increasing consumer concern regarding food, and we would like to see environmental and ethical concerns being made a priority by the Federal Government..
