Dear Sir:

- 1/ The rules and regulations should insure the ethical treatment of animals.
- 2/ The percentages of fat should be based upon calories rather than weight or volume. Persons on a low-fat diet should base their fat intake as a percentage of calories.

e.g. Logical: 70% less fat.

$$\frac{\% \text{ fat by}}{\text{calories}} = \frac{\text{gm fat} / 100\text{gm} \times 3700}{\text{kg} / 100\text{gm}} = \frac{23.0 \times 3700}{850} = 100\% \text{ fat}$$

e.g. Yoplait: 98% fat free

$$\frac{\% \text{ fat by}}{\text{calories}} = \frac{1.9 \times 3700}{360} = 19.5\% \text{ fat}$$
